This Privacy and Security statement is based upon the principles covered in Canada's Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA) as well as Ontario's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA). Privacy Policy

1. Privacy Philosophy and General Terms:

Niagara College Student Administrative Council understands the importance of your privacy rights. We are committed to transparency and disclosure of the ways in which we use personal and non-personal information.

The material you post on the social network site may be made public unless you adjust settings to restrict the availability of that material. In addition, there may be links to independent web sites outside of the Niagara College Student Administrative Council and we are not responsible for the privacy policies of those sites.

We will enforce all measures to secure the integrity of private communication on the site, however, even protected sites can be compromised due to illegal hacking, technological glitches, user misconduct, and administrative errors. Niagara College Student Administrative Council assumes no liability for these actions, occurrences or their results.

2. Information We Gather, IP Address and Cookies:

Visitors to the site may remain anonymous by not logging in. Niagara College Student Administrative Council uses cookies to gather non-personal information from visitors. This helps us to customize options, keep track of your whereabouts on the site and make proper amendments to its functionality.

The only data retained or made available is that which you post on your public profile. Please do not post any personal identification numbers, or other private information not required for registering or using the site.

Students will use their “students.niagaracollege.ca” e-mail address to register for both ncsac.ca and its accompanying social media network. These e-mail addresses may be used to compile e-mail lists for important updates relevant to Niagara College Student Administrative Council. At no point will this information be used to solicit, or procure third party interests. You will only receive e-mails from the staff of Niagara College Student Administrative Council.
